POLICY ON THE USE OF RECORDING EQUIPMENT, CAMERAS ETC AT MEETINGS

The use of photographic/sound recording equipment by the Press is permitted subject to prior notification being given to the Proper Officer in order that the Chairman of the Committee/Meeting concerned can be formally advised. The Chairman may withdraw the right to use the equipment at any time during the meeting.

The use of sound recording equipment, camcorders, other video equipment and cameras by the public is considered to cause disruption and could cause offence to some people and accordingly such use is not allowed. However, the Chairman of a meeting (in consultation with the Proper Officer) may allow the use of such equipment where circumstances dictate that this would be acceptable (e.g. presentations)
