6. TO RATIFY THE AGREED TERMS OF THE PROPOSED LOAN AGREEMENT BETWEEN FOREST ROW PARISH COUNCIL AND FROWRESOURCE CIC.

At the meeting of 15th March Council resolved that in addition to a grant from the Bendall legacy, a loan of £9,500 would be offered to FrowResource CIC on terms to be agreed. For the avoidance of doubt, it is lawful for the Parish Council to make such a loan, pursuant to section 12 of the Local Government Act 2003, as facilitated by the Localism Act 2011. There was a consensus that the terms of the loan should be decided by a small group taken from the Finance & Policy Committee. That group consisted of Cllr R Lewin, T Lewin, and Spackman, with written input from Cllrs Waters, Williams & Wogan.

For the avoidance of doubt the Clerk sat in with the group and was responsible for circulating the relevant papers, but played no part in formulating the proposed terms of the loan agreement.

The group met in person on Friday last and considered a preliminary draft prepared by ClIr R Lewin. After discussion of certain alternative clauses, the draft was set out in the form of Heads of Terms and sent to FrowResource on Friday evening at 18:24.

To the best of my knowledge, the members of the FrowResource Board have been circulating the document over the past few days and are holding a formal meeting today (Wednesday) to formulate their response to the proposals. It is hoped that their response will be substantially positive, so that an agreement can be concluded with all speed. If there are details to be discussed, we have 5 days (including the weekend) to conclude an agreement. Time is of the essence, since the favourable terms offered by the prospective landlord only hold good until 1st April. But it is my view that if the terms are agreed in writing, this will form an enforceable contract even if the formal loan document enshrining those terms takes a little longer to engross.

On the assumption that terms will be agreed in writing by the time of this meeting, the Committee (acting under the terms of paragraph 5.1 of the Scheme of Delegation) will be invited to ratify that agreement on behalf of the Council. Please note this is <u>not</u> a drafting meeting: the group of councillors acted as delegates of the Committee in formulating the proposed terms, and it is my professional view that those terms are lawful and enforceable. Members of course remain free to vote for or against ratification as they choose

7. TO CONSIDER A GRANT APPLICATION BY FOREST ROW COMMUNITY FRIDGE CIC.

Council also voted at the meeting of 15th March:

"to establish a coordinating committee to help Ukrainians coming to Forest Row. ... This should start as soon as possible to help with lines of communications and support."

There has been a preliminary discussion, in the course of which it was noted that either refugees or their sponsors might be in urgent need of food items or personal hygiene products but might not yet be in receipt of applicable benefits, and that those items could be provided by the local Community Fridge (which has broadened its remit to include food bank and hygiene bank outreach).

The suggestion was therefore made by one councillor that as we are now on the cusp of the financial year-end and there is still a fair sum (*currently £5,500) left in the Council's grant-making budget, the Community Fridge could apply for that money as a ring-fenced grant to be used (only) to provide goods in kind for the benefit of Ukrainian refugees either directly or through their registered sponsors.

I am in receipt of a grant application form, and attach the form and the latest Community Fridge accounts. The CIC is exempt from audit under section 477 of the Companies Act **ACTION: to resolve as appropriate**
